Insurance Policies

- We are committed to assisting you in obtaining your insurance benefits.
- If the insurance carrier fails to pay their estimated part of your benefit, the Parent/Responsible Party will become fully responsible for any remaining balance.
- Pre-authorizations, authorizations, and estimations of benefits are not a guarantee of payment. Orthodontic insurance benefits are based on a month-to-month eligibility to be a payable benefit.
- A new insurance policy may become effective after treatment has started, but most likely the insurance company will not cover pre-existing rendered treatment.
- Most insurance companies do not pay one lump sum. They may pay in monthly, quarterly or annual installments.
- If the insurance terminates, coverage terminates, benefits will stop immediately and the treatment will be terminated immediately, unless the Parent/Responsible Party pays out-of-pocket any remaining balance.
- If you lose your benefits, notify the office immediately.
- Orthodontic coverage may be subject to a waiting period.
- Adults are most likely not eligible for orthodontic coverage. Age limits and other restrictions are in effect under most insurance policies.

Privacy Policies

- The office may disclose the patient's health information to a family member, friend, or other person(s) to the extent necessary to assist with healthcare or with payment information, but only if the adult patient, parent/legal guardian agrees that the office can do so. The patient or parent/legal guardian must fill out a [HIPAA Release Form](#) if he/she wishes to allow accessibility to pertinent health information. Without a signed copy of the file, the only person that will receive any information will be the Responsible Party as appears in this contract.
